for the period 1 April to 30 June 2019

\$13,000.00 will be given to TSA United Church (Budget \$12,200).

\$1,300.00 will be given to Charity (Budget -\$1,220.00) – Renfrew Food Bank.

\$402.70 will be given to the UCW to reimburse for sales on Saturdays that they operate The Thrift Shop (Budget \$1,000).

Number of days open: 36 (2018: 37).

Average number of customers per day: 61 (2018: 53).

Average sales per day: \$426.86 (2018: \$360.80).

Average sale per customer: \$6.99 (2018: \$6.79).

Net sales for Quarter 2: \$14,710.80 (2018: \$13,052.89).

Net sales for Q2 were up \$1,657.91 from Q2 2018 with 1 fewer day open in 2019.
