## **Update from Church Council, Monday, June 22, 2022**

### **TSA Door "Open/Locked" Management Plan for Personnel & Property Security**

To prevent unauthorized access to Trinity-St. Andrew's the following requirements are being put in place. These will be reviewed and revised as necessary in September.

**Office Hours** - When the office is open (Monday to Thursday from 9 to 2) the front door will be open. Anyone wanting to do business in the building will enter that door and report to the office. A **sign** will be posted on the backdoor to tell any visitors to enter through the front door and report to the office so Deb knows they are there.

**Thrift Shop Hours** - When the **shop is open** (Thursday 12 to 6 and Saturday 10 to 2) the Quarry Street door will be open and the back door locked. The back door will be open for a short period before opening to let volunteers enter.

When volunteers are in to **sort/organize** (Monday & Wednesday from 9 to 2, and Friday 9 to 12) the Quarry Street door and the back door open will be open. The Thrift Shop lead is responsible for making sure both doors are locked when they leave.

If volunteers are **working other times** (eg Tuesday) the Quarry Street and back doors will remain locked and they **must** notify the office that they are in the building.

**Meetings and Planned Activities** - For these activities, the back door may be unlocked to facilitate access for the meeting/activity but should be locked by the person in charge when all members are present or 15 minutes after the start time for the meeting/activity.

**Sunday Service** – the backdoor/side door and front door will be open at 7:30ish for access to the Lutheran Service (8:45) and our service (10:00) and locked following TSA fellowship.

#### **Special Cases -**

Will be considered and communicated on an individual basis:

**Summer Camp** - entry will be through the Quarry Street doors, the backdoor must remain locked, the front door will be locked when the office is not open, and the Quarry Street doors locked when the Thrift Shop people are not in and all children have arrived.
