### **Report from finance at the end of September**

Total revenue:	\$209,890.11
Total expense:	\$220,087.91

Note: The Q3 revenue from the thrift shop is not in. The special appeals Blue Grass service collection for Ukraine raised \$3,326.50. The drive through fish fry, done in June raised about \$1500 Well done to all. The 'Share the Harvest' project done with St James for raising funds for the Renfrew Food Bank was in the beginning of October and around \$1000 was raised. Thanks to all the great volunteers and donors and buyers. Since in the summer many are away enjoying their summer break please consider PAR (Pre-Authorized Remittance) as a way for offering as it provides better continuity in TSA finances.
