### **Spring 2024 financial update**

**Operating:** The financial update for the end of May 2024 compared to 2023

2024 Income \$98,230; Expenses \$141,734; Net -\$43,504

2023 Income \$89,462; Expenses \$130,326; Net -\$40,864

**Note** 2024 includes \$6,600 payment to UCC (half the annual assessment set by General Council) while in 2023 payment had not yet been made. 2024 Thrift Shop was up \$6500 over 2023.

### **Stewardship:**

- Spring plant sale brought in ~\$4100, and the proceeds were donated to camp Lau-Ren. This is the largest fund raiser/donation to camp Lau-Ren compared to any church in the region. Well done!!
- Special collection on camping Sunday brought in \$1816 for camp Lau-Ren
- Rainbow Service Grant \$5000 received from EOORC Vision and Transformation Fund
- Community Luncheon.... the free will donations are covering costs and providing lunch to about 55 people per month.
