National Council of Canadians Postcard Campaign to Encourage Renfrew County to Create a Climate Action Committee: The Council of Canadians is an independent citizen's organization founded in 1985. Founding members include Margaret Atwood and Pierre Berton. They advocate for health care, climate action, water protection and the corporate capture of many public institutions. For Earth Day in 2024, the Renfrew chapter presented a petition to Renfrew County Council asking them to initiate a Climate Action Committee for the Upper Ottawa Valley. They believe it will help our citizens mitigate the effects from climate change. The County is currently undertaking an energy audit of their fossil fuel usage and has not acted on this request. Barb Moogk is a member of the local chapter of the Council of Canadians and she has brought postcards for people to sign. They will be shared with Renfrew County Council to encourage them on this issue. You are invited to join Barb in the Chapel
